Integration includes design, mill use, characterization and finishing techniques to deliver restorations.

For a successful Integration Day:

- Schedule 3 patients
 - Select staff, family or friends who will be accommodating patients while you are learning
 - We recommend these patients are prepped and scanned into your PlanCAD software
 - Full coverage crown or **maximum** of 3-unit bridge restorative case
- Order blocks and discs in shade values for upcoming patients (see below for further instructions)
- Lab handpiece and Finishing/Polishing Kit
- Sand blaster for preparing Zirconia for cementation
